Heres how to enter... phone your entries through to Michele Dearn 0490 915 641 or Marg Curnow 0466 534 274. Entries close Thursday March 30th and will be received up until 12 noon that day. No late entries will be accepted. All exhibits except Floral Art must be grown by exhibitor. Entries may be staged between 5pm and 7pm on Friday, and MUST be staged by 10am Saturday. Hall will be opened at 8 am on Saturday. No late entries will be accepted. Prize money: Unless stated, in lieu of prize money, first, second and third prize cards will be awarded in all classes. Best exhibit and aggregate will be awarded ribbons as stated below. Floral Art prize money will be paid on Sunday afternoon.
